



Antisana Condor Tour

- Early morning pick up from your Hotel in Quito, between 5:00 am - 5:30 am.
- Visit our Antisana Condor Observatory Reserve for spectacular view of the Andean Condor in their nesting and sleeping grounds.
- Continue to Antisana National Park and stop along the way at strategic location for other bird species like CaraCaras, Lawings, Hawks, Gulls, Antpittas and others.
- Explore Secas or La Mica Lagoon for aquatic bird species and boxed lunch.
- Continue to Hummingbird Feeders for Giant Hummingbird, Sword-billed Hummingbird and others. Return to Quito and drop off at your hotel.

Target Birds: Andean Condor, Shining Sunbeam, Giant Hummingbird, Black Flowerpiercer, Caraculated Cara Cara, Variable Hawk, Black-chested Buzzard Eagle, Andean Coot, Andean Teal, Ruddy Duck, Andean Gull, Many-striped Canastero, Tyrian Metaltail, American Kestrel, Brown-backed Chat Tyrant, Red-crested Cotinga, Ecuadorian Hillstar, Spectacled Redstart and if we are lucky possible the Spectacled Bear!

Papallacta Pass and East Slope Cloud Forest

- Early in the morning we will pick you up from your hotel in Quito and start our Top Birding Tour to the East Slope Cloud Forest Reserve. We will stop at the mountainous range of Andes Mountains at Papallacta Pass to possible observe 3 spectacular and rare species of hummingbirds like **Ecuadorian Hillstar**, **Rainbow-bearded Thornbill**, and **Blue-mantled Thornbill**.
- Continue birding in Papallacta Pass, a transition Montane Forest between the Andes and the Eastern Cloud Forest. Possible to observe Tawny Antpitta, Rufous-bellied Seedsnipe and Spectacled Bear. Then upon arrival to the reserve we will devote some time at the Hummingbird feeders. At the reserve we will also have the opportunity to explore the main trail around the lodge for possible **Torrent Duck**, **White-capped Dipper**, **Hooded Mountain Tanager**, **Masked Trogon**, **Andean Potoo**, **Grey-breasted Mountain Toucan**, **Andean Guan**, **Slaty-backed Chat-tyrant**, **Mountain Cacique**, **Turquoise Jay** and others. After lunch return to Quito and drop off at your hotel.

Andean Cock of the Rock Lek Tour

- Early pick up around 4am from your hotel in Quito. Drive towards the West Slope Cloud Forest near Tandayapa Valley.
- Visit Angel Paz Reserve famous for the Andean Cock of the Rock Lek.
- Birding in the Reserve at the Antpittas Hides, Tanager, Quetzals, Toucans, and Humming-bird Feeders.
- Visit Alambi Hummingbird Paradise and Lunch.
- Return to Quito in the afternoon. Drop off at your hotel.

Target Bird Species: Andean Cock of the Rock, Black-winged Saltator, Masked Trogon, Ornate Flycatcher, Red-headed Barbet, Toucan Barbet, Crimson-mantled Woodpecker, Crimson-rumped Toucanet, Golden-headed Quetzal, Rufous Antpitta, Giant Antpitta, Ochre-breasted Antpitta, Yellow-breasted Antpitta, Dark-backed Wood-Quail, Flame-faced Tanager, Golden-napped Tanager, Bronze-winged Parrot, Red-billed Parrot, Violet-tailed Sylph, Andean Emerald, White-necked Jacobin, Green-crowned Woodnymph, others.

Zuro Loma Antpittas and Yanacocha Foothills

- Pick Up 530am from Quito and drive towards Zuro Loma Reserve located in the North Western part of Quito. Upon arrival to the reserve we will devote the first hour to explore the Antpitta and Hummingbird feeders.
- Continue birding in Yanacocha Reserve observing hummingbirds and possible critical endangered Black-breasted Puffleg. Lunch at the Reserve overlooking the Canopy of the Upper Mountain Forest and Cloud Forest. Possible White-throated Screech Owl. After-noon return to Quito.

Target Bird Species: Black-chested Mountain Tanager, Scarlet-bellied Mountain Tanager, Grey-browed Brush Finch, Chestnut-naped Antpitta, Equatorial Antpitta, Andean Guan, Masked Flowerpiercer, Glossy Flowerpiercer, Southern-Yellow Grosbeak, Shining Sunbeam, Sword-billed Hummingbird, Great-Sapphirewing, Buff-tailed Coronet, Superciliated Hemispingus, Sapphire-vented puffleg, Golden-breasted Puffleg, Buff-winged Starfrontlet, Purple-backed Thornbill, Rainbow-bearded Thornbill and others.
